



TAKING DOGS INTO THE USA - CDC UPDATE - July 22, 2024

Are you planning on taking ANY* dogs across the Canadian-USA border this summer?

*including a family pet, service dog, a dog being rescued or re-homed, a dog moving to the USA, a dog receiving (or received) medical care, etc.

Please see below, and visit our website for important forms and the necessary steps needed to take your dog across the USA border.

The updated (and simplified) new changes will go into effect on August 1, 2024

What do I need to do before my trip? STARTING AUG 1, 2024	
Dog's age?	Will your dog be at least 6 months old on the day of travel?
Microchip?	Your dog must have a microchip that can be read by a universal scanner.
	The following form needs to be filled out, and will be valid for multiple entries for six months from issue date of the receipt: Dog Import Form
Healthy?	The dog must appear healthy upon arrival.
Rabies Certificate?	A valid rabies certificate is needed to bring your dog back into Canada.


